I am very excited to announce the results of this week's ASG Election and Student Referendum!

After 3 weeks of [campaigning](#), [debating](#), and get-out-the-vote efforts, the results are in. **This year, our election had the most student engagement in the history of our College**, with over 1400 votes cast. This is 40% more than our previous record set in 2015, and over quadruple the number of votes cast last year, which was 308 votes. Without even taking the results into account, we are proud to have succeeded in engaging more students than ever before, despite declining enrollment.
