Dear Dr. Beebe,

I, Mchl Sykes, coming to you as current Commissioner of Events for ASG, and in solidarity with the rest of the ASG position holders; am writing to inform you of the ASG's recent decision to host an event circulated around student expression, and healing in regards to the recent derogatory remarks made by Vice President of Business Services, Lyndsay Maas.

As representatives of the SBCC student body, it is vital that you understand all of us (students), whether conscience of it or not, have been affected by the comment(s) of a Lyndsey Maas, and by the actions taken by your board in response to this comment(s). We request that you suspend the rules prohibiting Lyndsay Maas's presence on campus for the duration of this event, and also that you see to informing her of our demand that she be present at this event centered around healing and expression.

The event will take place before the end of the semester, and likely before finals week. We do not want time to pass and for students grades and performance to suffer anymore than they have due to the frustration and anxiety of this being thrust upon them, without being presented the space and time to express themselves and release these emotions. Equally, we extend this as an invitation for VP Lyndsay Maas to officially and publicly apologize to her constituents, in a safe, organized, and transparent manner. The event will function similarly to the special BoT meeting that was held on Nov. 19th: an agenda being made visible in advance showing the meeting opening with a statement made by VP Lyndsay Maas , followed by the majority of time being allowed for public comment by students, ending with a closing statement from Lyndsay Maas. VP Maas will not be allowed to respond directly to any comments as they are made, only encouraged to listen as our constituents express themselves. The current members of the ASG will join Lyndsay Maas at the board table, and direct the flow of communication.

Being that she is the primary catalyst of the need for this event, and that she has not made a physical public comment to the student body directly, we find her presence essential and imperative to the success and purpose of this event. Her safety is assured, and will be seen to directly by ASG and Security. We ask for a hasty response from you on whether she will be present at our event or not.
